Relazione

Il questionario utilizzato per la rilevazione delle opinioni dei dottori di ricerca è stato prodotto sulla base della bozza fornita dall'ANVUR. Il questionario, organizzato in due sezioni principali (sezione A "indici qualitativi" e sezione B "indici quantitativi"), consta di n. 75 domande in lingua inglese ed è stato somministrato ai dottori di ricerca dei cicli 34 e 35, raccogliendo le risultanze in forma anonima attraverso la piattaforma Microsoft Forms.

Il questionario ha esplorato aspetti relativi a didattica, ricerca, esperienza di studio/ricerca all'estero, produzione scientifica, supervisione, supporto finanziario e organizzativo, disponibilità di spazi e strumentazioni per la ricerca e gestione delle procedure amministrative.

Il questionario, somministrato in data 31 ottobre 2023, ha registrato un tasso di risposta del 50% (5 risposte su 10 dottori di ricerca totali).

In relazione ai punti di forza, emerge che il Dottorato di Ricerca prevede un'attività di formazione e di training in lingua inglese che complessivamente registra un tasso di soddisfazione da parte dei dottori di ricerca del 100%. Per quanto concerne i periodi di studio e ricerca all'estero presso Università o altre istituzioni, si registra un tasso complessivo di soddisfazione del 100%. Inoltre, il 100% dei dottori di ricerca dichiara di essere soddisfatti dell'attività di supervisione da parte dei docenti e delle attività di ricerca e di tesi.



Il 100% dei dottori di ricerca ha pubblicato articoli su riviste scientifiche e l'80% ha presentato i risultati della propria ricerca all'estero e il 100% dei dottori di ricerca ritiene che le aule e i laboratori di ricerca siano adeguati.

Infine, l'80% dei dottori di ricerca risulta pienamente soddisfatto del Dottorato di Ricerca e si iscriverebbe nuovamente al Dottorato di Ricerca e all'Università Parthenope.

In relazione ai punti di debolezza, non si evidenziano particolari criticità. Tuttavia, emerge che il 40% dei dottori di ricerca ritiene insufficienti le postazioni di lavoro. Il 40% dei dottori di ricerca dichiara di non aver ricevuto dai docenti un'adeguata informazione circa lo svolgimento del periodo all'estero mentre il 20% non risulta soddisfatto del supporto fornito dal personale amministrativo.

Infine, nonostante l'80% dei dottori di ricerca risulti pienamente soddisfatto del Dottorato di Ricerca, dal questionario emerge un forte interesse dei dottori di ricerca verso programmi di dottorato di ricerca all'estero.




21. During the course, were research activities conducted jointly with other universities? (0 punto)


